



LIVESTOCK SHOWS

What to bring for the show????

1. Your animal project(s).
2. Feed
3. Feed pan(s) and water bucket(s).
4. Show Box-container to carry and hold all show equipment:
 - >Grooming supplies: shampoo, brushes, combs, towels, clippers, halters, small hose with spray nozzle, animal blankets, thermometer.
 - >Show supplies: show halter, show collar, show stick, brush or comb. (species specific)
5. Show clothes. You should present yourself in a clean well groomed and professional manner in the show ring. Flip flops, shorts, tank/spaghetti strap tops, ripped jeans are NOT appropriate in the show ring. A long sleeve button shirt, clean jeans, belt, and leather shoes or boots are customary show clothes. Dairy projects, rabbit and poultry may have specific show attire. Check with your club leader and superintendent.
6. Number to your veterinarian, copies of bill of sale and COOL forms.
7. Chairs for you to sit down.
8. Chain and/or clip to lock your animals in their pens at night. You can use wire or even a zip tie.
9. Fan to keep animal projects cool and comfortable.
10. Shovel and broom to keep pen area or stall clean.
11. Bedding for your pen or stall is purchased on the fair grounds.

Read all notices that are posted for show times, classes, and showcase sale. You are responsible for your animal project and its care! Any questions always check with your species superintendent.
