Participants will be judged during the afternoon and then the Fashion Revue Show and awards will be presented in the evening. Because Cloverbuds are not judged, they only need to attend the evening Fashion Revue Show. See the schedule listed above.

## Classes will be as follows:

Class 1: Junior Clothing Construction (STEAM 1, 2 & 3)

Class 2: Intermediate Clothing Construction (STEAM 1, 2 & 3)

Class 3: Senior Clothing Construction (STEAM 1, 2 & 3)

Class 4: Junior Artistic Clothing DYD & Creative Sewing, Heritage Arts and Leathercraft

Class 5: Intermediate Artistic Clothing DYD & Creative Sewing, Heritage Arts and Leathercraft

Class 6: Senior Artistic Clothing DYD & Creative Sewing, Heritage Arts and Leathercraft

Class 7: Junior Artistic Clothing Buymanship

Class 8: Intermediate Artistic Clothing Buymanship

Class 9: Senior Artistic Clothing Buymanship

Class 10: Junior Modeling for Fun

Class 11: Intermediate Modeling for Fun

Class 12: Senior Modeling for Fun

Class 13: Cloverbud Modeling for Fun (Participation only)

## Awards

1. All entries will be judged using the Danish System (blue, red, white and participation ribbons) according to quality. Cloverbuds do not compete and only receive participation ribbons.
2. Only entries in the **blue ribbon** category are eligible for reserve champion or champion in each class. All reserve champions or champions are on the merit system and the judge will determine merit. No reserve champion will be given unless a champion ribbon is given.
3. The top blue senior in Class 3, 6 and 9 will be eligible to advance to State Fair. Second blue seniors will be alternates. Seniors in Modeling for Fun or seniors who make accessories to model (instead of garments) cannot advance to State Fair.
4. From the Reserve Champions and Champions of each class, Overall Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and Honorable Mention will be designated in each age division (junior, intermediate and senior) by the judges – to include classes 1-12. These are “Judge’s Choice Awards” and do not confer eligibility to participate in State Fair.

## Fashion Revue Rules (This does not include Modeling for Fun)

1. County youth enrolled in Clothing Construction STEAM 1, 2 & 3 (exception: Sewing for Others), Artistic Clothing Decorate Your Duds, Artistic Clothing Creative Sewing, Artistic Clothing Buymanship,

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Heritage Arts and Leathercraft are eligible to participate.

2. Garments made during the current club year in fulfillment of project requirements are eligible for competition. Participation in other (non-4-H) contests does not eliminate them from this event.
3. All garments modeled by participants must also be entered and judged in the appropriate exhibit day division.
4. Participants model wearable garments they have made for themselves. (Seniors who make accessories such as purses, belts, etc. to model will not be eligible for State Fair.)
5. Contestants may model in more than one unit class.

## Modeling for Fun Rules

1. Any youth may participate in the “Modeling for Fun” contest, even if they are not enrolled in one of the projects listed above in #1.
2. Participants may model an outfit purchased at the store for school or a special occasion, or an outfit made for them by someone else.
3. The participants will explain in their commentary why they chose this outfit, where they plan to wear it, and how the outfit compliments their style and personality.
4. Youth who enter this category will be able to participate in the workshop and Fashion Revue and learn modeling techniques and confidence on stage.
5. The same judging guide used for clothing projects will be used for Modeling For Fun.
6. Contestants will be split into age divisions (Cloverbud, junior, intermediate, and senior); however senior “Modeling for Fun” contestants will not be able to qualify for the State 4-H Fashion Revue.

## Judging Guide for Fashion Revue
