- Horse show office will open one hour prior to show time each day.
- 4-H age group/level classes are for any youth enrolled in the 4-H Horse project or FFA in Colorado. OPEN classes are open to anyone (4-H members, non 4-H members and adults). Youth must be at least 8 years of age for open classes.
- No late entries – only drops will be taken the day of the show. No refunds will be made to class changes unless the health of the horse or the health of the rider are an issue.
- Please review your entries with your parents and/or club leader to make sure you are entering the correct classes for your age and riding level.
- Classes with three or less exhibitors can be combined with similar age/level classes at the discretion of the management.
- All 4-H exhibitors will complete the written test on **Monday, June 5th** from 5:30 -7:00 P.M. ***This test will be in the Colorado Building at the Colorado State Fairgrounds.*** Out of county contestants must take the test the first thing in the morning or during the lunch break **the day of the show.**
- **Exhibitors must compete in a showmanship class to compete in any other classes.** 4-H age groups (age 12/31/16): Senior 14-18 years old, Junior 8-13 years old.
- The highest level an exhibitor has achieved as of June 4th will be the level they compete at Spring Show.
- Written test points will be included in high point tabulation. The written test must be taken to be eligible to compete in any classes. A random class will be drawn to break all ties.
- Year end horse awards (Versatility and Supreme Horse) will be awarded at Pueblo County Achievement Night – see specific rules for these awards. Points from Ranch Horse, Gymkhana, Western and English divisions will be included (not to include Green Horse or Foal). Miniature Division is not eligible for versatility. Youth could compete for supreme but would just only earn points in the mini division. The correct horse's names must be on pre-registration form for each class entered. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!!!
- 4-H Classes are open to any exhibitor that is a current member of a 4-H club enrolled in the Colo horse project.
- "Green Horse" classes are offered for horses not yet experienced enough to enter regular classes and riders who are at least a Level 2. Horses may only be shown in the "Green Horse" division for one year and may not be shown in any other classes. Once the horse is shown in any other class, they are not eligible to be shown in "Green Horse" again.
- Breaks for tack changes, warm up and lunch will be taken where appropriate and will be announced.
- Please notify the gate person of any scheduling conflicts and show management will do their best to accommodate.
- All other rules will be followed in accordance with the current Colorado State 4-H Horse Show Rulebook 2015 & 2016 Pueblo County Fair Book rules.
- It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the 4-H member to see that the headgear worn complies with such standards and is in good condition. The state 4-H office encourages the use of ASTM certified/SEI approved safety helmets in all equine events. Use of protective headgear is encouraged and shall not be discriminated against. Helmets are highly recommended for youth in all events while on or off the horse. This decision will be left to the parent/guardian's discretion in classes where helmets are not required.

(NOTE FOR BEGINNER RIDERS:

- ❖ Beginner Western riders have the **option** of riding one or two handed. Legal Western tack must be used. Shank bits must be used on horses 6 years or older. A ringed snaffle or bosal may only be used on horses 5 years or younger and must be ridden with two hands. Please refer to 2015 Colorado Horse Show Rulebook for complete Western Division rules.
- ❖ Beginner riders will only be allowed to walk/trot while on the fairgrounds. **ALL LEVELS** should not exceed a rider's abilities.

SUNDAY, JUNE 11 2017

RANCH HORSE – CHECK IN 8:00 AM SHOW STARTS AT 9:00 AM -

A youth must have passed a Level 1 Ranch Horse Test (written and riding to qualify you to show in Level 1 Ranch Horse Classes. Level 1 Ranch Horse will not be allowed to work cattle. If you are entering Level 2 or above, you must pass the appropriate Ranch Horse Level Riding Test to enter these classes and be able to enter cattle classes. Any participant working with cattle must be a level 2 rider or above. Additional fees will be collected at the time of entry for cattle classes if there are enough entered to warrant obtaining cattle.

General Working Ranch Horse Rules:

- Hoof polish is not required or recommended.
- No braided or banded manes or tail extensions.
- Trimming inside ears is discouraged.
- Trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair.
- Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
- Showmanship -- Horses are to be shown in a good working halter: rope, braided, nylon or plain leather.
- Youth must use the same horse in all Working Ranch

Rules for 75 Up & Back:

Only one contestant will run at a time. Contestant will race 75 yards up the arena around the stake or barrel and return across the starting line for a time. Running start. If the marker is knocked over, contestant is not disqualified or assessed a time penalty. Disqualification includes rider falls from horse, horse falls, horse makes full turn prior to or after rounding the designated marker and crossing back over time line before completion of the pattern.
