

Pueblo County Fair & 4-H Superintendent Application

4-H and Pueblo County Fair Superintendents provide input, guidance and help interpret Pueblo County Fair/Pueblo County 4-H competition rules in cooperation with CSUE staff and the Pueblo County Fair Board. Superintendents serve in both 4-H and Pueblo County Fair capacities, unless otherwise directed by CSUE and the Fair Board.

Superintendents are supportive members of 4-H and the Pueblo County Fair and are expected to adhere to the 4-H Code of Conduct and Pueblo County 4-H Policies at all times. Please note that Superintendent roles are based on the needs of the 4-H Program and that of the Pueblo County Fair, and can expand or retract based on current enrollment, program demand, etc.

If selected, individuals may be asked to become a 4-H volunteer and complete a background check.

Application Process:

- October 4: Applications open and are posted to CSU Extension and Fair Board Websites.
- October 4 October 25: Open application period.
- October 28 November 1: Selection Committee reviews applications
- November 8: All candidates notified of the Selection Committee's decision
- January 1: Superintendents assume their roles.
