# Joining Pueblo County 4-H Community Clubs

## When can I join?

Enrollment Opens: Mid-October  
(Some clubs fill up quickly so call ahead!)

Enrollment Closes: February 1st  
(Members who enroll after this cannot compete in County Fair!)

Enrollment Fee: \$30 for members; \$20 for Cloverbuds  
(Members aged 8-18, Cloverbuds aged 5-7, age as of December 31st)

## How do I join?

1. Visit [pueblo.extension.edu](http://pueblo.extension.edu) to find a list of 4-H Clubs in Pueblo County
2. Call the volunteer club leader and ask questions like:
  - Do you have room for additional members?
  - Where and when do you meet?
  - What projects does your club offer?
  - Are there any additional club requirements?
3. Select the club most compatible with your family and get their approval
4. Enroll on 4HOnline and pay the CSU Extension Office (701 Court St. Suite C, Pueblo, CO 81003)
